On Sunday 17th July we had over 40 taking part in Huntshaw's Walking Treasure Hunt of about 4 miles starting and finishing at the church with a BBQ in the shadiest part of the church yard we could find (the front ally way). There were 30 clues spread around the route that went through footpath, field and Huntshaw Woods – taking in the ancient Manor of Great Huxhill (mentioned in the Doomsday Book), the majestic views from Berry Castle and even a very welcome halfway stopover point at Honey Wood Orchard to sample an apple juice or cider.

To the quizmaster's surprise (on what seemed like the hottest day of the century), when asked if they enjoyed it as they staggered round the corner back to church in the intense heat, almost all said that they did! Team PPA won the prize with 26 points — a handsome mixed box from Heddon's of Woodtown, closely followed by Hilary & Colin and 'Sizzling Heat' on 25 pts, Team Overton on 24 and the 'Huntshaw Hotties' on 23 (and so on!).

Special thanks go to Les Birch who had the hottest task of standing by and cooking all the burgers for us. After setting off at 2ish all walkers were back by 5.30pm and most stayed on in a social group round the bbq till about 7pm. In all we raised another £414 for the Bell Fund and many who couldn't make it because of the heat have promised a donation as they're keen to do the walk when its cooler. We hope to put on a concert on October 15th but details to follow on this one. Out of the £30k needed for repairs we have another 5.5k go so definitely light at the end of the tunnel now.
