

ALVERDISCOTT & HUNTSHAW PARISH COUNCIL Vacancy for the position of Parish Clerk

The Clerk is the Proper Officer of the Council and is responsible to the Council for all aspects of administration of day-to-day business, preparing agendas and taking minutes of meetings, advising on regulatory and legal matters, and managing the Parish Councils website. The applicant must have good organisational, communication and IT skills and while it will be an advantage to hold the Certificate in Local Council Administration (CiLCA) this is not essential. The Clerk will mainly work from home and is required to attend 6 evening parish council meetings per annum (normally held bi-monthly), an Annual Parish Meeting and such other council meetings as may be decided. This is a part-time post with hours proportionate to the workload at the time. The salary would be £1,800 per annum paid on a quarterly basis, plus any expenses arising directly from the necessary activities involved.

This position may also be suitable for a Clerk to another Parish who is already processing incoming mail from DALC and District/County Councils who has hours available for additional responsibilities. Before November is out, the men's football world cup will have begun in Qatar. For some, a glorious month will be spent watching match after match... and no doubt cheering England to the trophy! For others it will be a thing to avoid.

In our house we will be cheering for Wales. I was ordained in Wales and all our children were born there. Wales have made it to their first world cup since 1958. Wales is not a large country, but a combination of good teamwork and a few outstanding players has enabled the team to make it to the promised land of the world cup finals. Go Wales!

Its amazing how far good teamwork can get you. Our communities and churches rely on it. St Paul tells the church in Corinth that the church is like a body – a single unit but made up of many parts. It's when each part does what it's designed to do that the whole body functions well (I Corinthians 12).

I've been really pleased to see the ways our churches are trying to do their bit to help others. At harvest, collections have been taken to help local people struggling to put food on the table or a roof over their head. Charities working with poor people oversees have also been supported. 
